## Get your permit!

Chickens, ducks, and any other livestock must have a permit from the City of Rawlins per RMC 6.05.020. Permits also required for bees, and wild and exotic animals.

- Pick up an application at the Animal Shelter or [www.rawlinswy.gov/livestock](http://www.rawlinswy.gov/livestock)
- Turn in application Animal Shelter or email to [animalcontrol@rawlinswy.gov](mailto:animalcontrol@rawlinswy.gov)
- Animal Control will visit at scheduled time to approve site as safe and weather ready
- Take approved application to City Hall to pay \$25 fee and receive your permit

# PARKING PROMPTS

## GUIDE TO LESS UNDERSTOOD PARKING LAWS

### FOLLOW GENERAL PARKING BEST PRACTICES

For a full list of all ordinances, please review the full text available at [rawlinswy.gov/code](http://rawlinswy.gov/code). For example, our code says you need to park near the curb, not park semis on city streets, follow all parking signs, not park near fire hydrants, etc.

### KEEP INTERSECTIONS CLEAR WITH SUFFICIENT VISIBILITY

At any intersection except in the business district:

- Parking is prohibited within 30 feet to any flashing signal, stop sign, yield sign, or traffic-control signal on the road of approach
- Parking is prohibited within 20 feet of any intersection on the road **without** a traffic control signal, such as a stop sign
- Parking of any item which is more than 6 feet tall for more than 6 feet of its length is prohibited in any direction within 40 feet of all intersections.

### VEHICLES AND TRAILERS CAN'T BE IN THE RIGHT-OF-WAY

Vehicles and trailers can only park outside the travel portion of the street, and must not interfere with vehicle or pedestrian traffic. No personal property or trash shall interfere with vehicle or pedestrian travel, including in alleys or sidewalks. Rawlins Municipal Code § 12.24.050 and Rawlins Municipal Code 10.33.040

### PRIVATE PROPERTY

Do not park for more than 24 hours on the street in front of someone's property without consent. § 10.33.170 Don't park or drive on private property without permission. You can be towed at your expense. Rawlins Municipal Code § 10.33.160

### PUBLIC NUISANCE VEHICLES

Abandoned, derelict, wrecked, dismantled, or inoperative vehicles AND unlicensed vehicles on private or public property is a public nuisance and can be removed at the owner's expense. Rawlins Municipal Code §8.16.010

### BUSINESS REGULATIONS

Businesses are not permitted to store their business vehicles or vehicles in for repair on alleys, streets, or sidewalks. Rawlins Municipal Code § 10.33.150

### STATE

In addition, we enforce all state parking regulations. One of note is that you must park in the direction of the flow of traffic. Wyo. Stat. §31-5-512(a)
